## Amazon Inspire

[Amazon Inspire](#) is an open collaboration service that allows K-12 teacher to discover, gather and share high quality, educational content with their peers. New resources are being added continuously. Title, subject, grade levels and standards can be used to search for resources. Other teachers can download and use resources shared by other teachers. Users can review and rate all resources on Amazon Inspire. This helps others find quality, vetted resources. Amazon Inspire will help teachers from all over the county discover digital resources, benefit and learn from the work of their peers, and help improve the quality of education.

### How to publish resources on Amazon Inspire

Teachers play an important part in contributing to Amazon Inspire. Proofread all documents to ensure that the resource is free from spelling and grammatical errors and follow these guidelines:

- Check the format to make sure that the resource is easy to use and understand. For example, the font and font size are legible and images are clear.
- Confirm that the content is well organized and the learning outcomes are clear.
- Review the content to ensure that it is accurate, current, and appropriate for your intended audience(s).
- Verify that the resource is complete, meaning it can be utilized on its own.
- Confirm that any resource you are uploading as a URL functions correctly, goes directly to an education resource (as opposed to a generic site), and does not require a login or payment to access.

### Files that can be uploaded include:

- Document: doc, docx, pdf, rtf, txt, xls, xlsx, ppt, pptx
- Image: bmp, gif, jpeg, jpg, png
- Video: flv, mov, mp4, mpeg, mpg, wmv

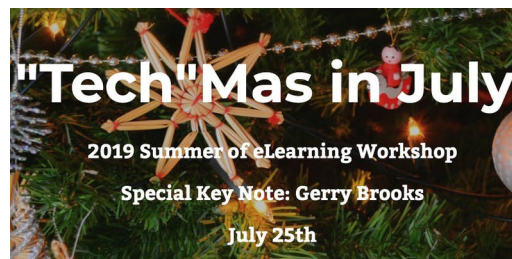
